Corning-Painted Post High School senior Wins 28th Annual Ernie Davis Scholarship of \$15,000

Taylor Jubilee, a senior at Corning-Painted Post High School, has been chosen as the 28th recipient of the Ernie Davis Memorial Scholarship through the Community Foundation of Elmira-Corning and the Finger Lakes, Inc. She was honored at a special ceremony in front of the Ernie Davis statue. Taylor will receive a total of \$15,000 over four years, \$3,750 per year, to be used toward her college tuition and expenses.

In addition to her athletic achievements in Track and Field, she was a member of the Student Council, National Honor Society, Interact Club, and French Club at her school. Taylor is also an active volunteer at the Arnot Ogden Medical Center, Guthrie Corning Hospital, and in her church. Each year, nominees are asked to develop and execute a project that will spread the word about Ernie Davis. Taylor created a calendar filled with facts about Ernie Davis and monumental dates in his life. Taylor gave presentations and distributed calendars at several community events, centers, schools.

Taylor is the daughter of Ivan and Krystal Jubilee and will study nursing at SUNY Stonybrook in the fall.
